Founded in 2010, Edible Schoolyard NYC (ESYNYC) is a nonprofit organization on a mission to make edible education accessible for every child in NYC. Our programming reaches over **4,000** students in over **30** NYC schools each year, helping students to:

Develop social and emotional learning skills by working together, taking risks, and trying new things




Feel more connected to their school community, and learn about other cultures




Our Impact

During the 2024-25 school year:







91% of students reported that working in the garden helped them understand where their food comes from

85% of teachers reported that ESYNYC helped their students understand at least one academic subject

One of my students, who usually struggles to stay engaged in the classroom, lit up with excitement while planting seeds in the garden. He said 'I didn't know I could grow food.'

This moment showed how powerful this experience can be for our kids.
